Wanda discussed her conversation with Rabecca Cisneros (Education Coordinator, State of Utah Charter School Board) and that Rabecca said the GBOT training is no longer supported and has been abandoned. Two ideas evolved: change the metric and/or ask board members to provide short presentations on basic board responsibilities such as ethics, financial oversight, and legal issues, especially for new members.
