MINUTES

TREASURER'S REPORT

- Budget doesn't reflect expenses or income associated with the turnaround
 - Received all three years of funding (\$240,000) in one lump sum State Revenues
 - Two payments to Turnaround consultants \$71,000
- 75% of the way through the fiscal year
 - Still waiting on some revenue streams (side note Wheeler Foundation gives money automatically every year)
 - o 95% state sources have been received
 - More carry forward than was projected
- Surplus of \$150,000 this year
- Everything else on track

ACTION ITEMS

- 1. Approve February minutes (attached)
 - a. Motion Kathy, Second Wanda
- 2. Approve policy for USBE Educator Engagement and Exit Surveys
 - a. USBE wants to survey teachers every other year for engagement and school climate; need to have a policy about it to protect teacher anonymity
 - b. Motion Steve, Second Bill
- 3. Approve temporary personnel policy for COVID-19 school closure.
 - a. In place from 4/1/2020 12/31/2020; adjusted categorized personnel levels (including approved leave for at-risk staff members) for UICS employees
 - b. Motion Alexx, Second Doug
- 4. Approve **request** to Granite School Board to add 6th grade and waive state deadline (would've been October 2019).
 - a. GSD sending 6^{th} grade to junior high therefore justifying the reasoning for UICS adding 6^{th} grade
 - i. UICS board members might have to help lobby with GSD board to ensure the expansion is approved

TEACHER REPORT

 - Teachers are frustrated with lack of going to online learning earlier than spring break
 - Teachers didn't feel that they had a platform to be heard during the COVID-19 online transition
 - Some concerns from teachers/office staff on if they need a mask or gloves when they go into the building
 - 7th and 8th grade teachers aren't seeing as much success with the online format (only 20% participation from students)
 - o One on one format has been nice for teachers and students
- Shout out to Lara (guidance counselor) getting students set up with internet

- Fraud risk assessment (Bill Anderson)
